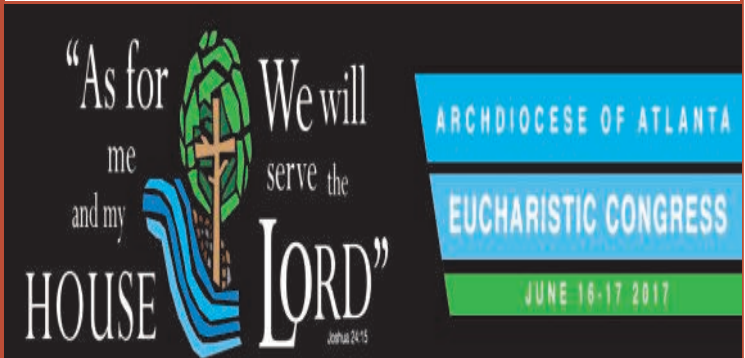


Couples Celebrating 50th & 60th Anniversary in 2017
