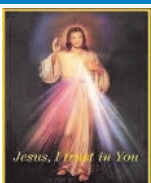

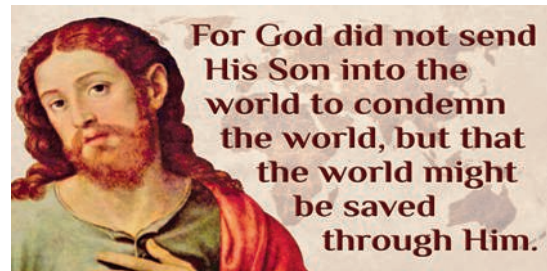

Baptism Classes
