Dear Parents,

As we begin a new year of religious education and faith formation I want to take this opportunity to extend a warm welcome to all of our students and their families and invite you to stop in your child’s class on the first Sunday of class to meet their Catechist.

You will notice that all classes kindergarten thru fifth grade are on Sunday Morning and only the middle school Edge, grades six, seventh and eighth are from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday evening.

Please see the schedule and keep one handy for future reference. We will be using a New Safe Environment Training Program from the Archdiocese and information is attached in this packet.

This year we will again be using Life Teens Edge Program for our middle school students.

There are no classes Sunday September 2nd due to the Labor Day Weekend holiday.

Again, Sunday, - K through 5th grade will meet: 9:45 a.m. – 10:45 a.m.

Sunday –Pre-K, 3&4 year olds will meet at 11:00 a. m. – 12 noon

Wednesday – Edge 6th, 7th, & 8th grades will meet from 6:00 p.m. – 7:30 pm.

Confirmation Sessions begin October 2018 and will meet from 9:30 a.m. – 10:45 a.m.

The following items listed below have been established to ensure the safety of your children. Hopefully, with your help and cooperation, this procedure will help make the class year run smoothly:

- Parents of Pre- K- through 5th grade are asked to bring their child to the classroom.
- For dismissal, a parent must come to the classroom to pick up their child.
No child will be allowed to leave the classroom without a parent. Please do not send an older sibling to get a younger brother or sister. The catechists have been instructed to dismiss a child only to a parent. This applies for all elementary grade levels.
- Students in grades 6 through 8 may be dropped off at the main entrance of the Church.
- Please wait to be sure your child has entered the building.

Please make every effort to insure your child is attending Mass weekly as this is vital to their spiritual and religious development.

I commend you for the work and effort you make in seeing that your children receive religious education formation. I thank you for entrusting your children with us.
